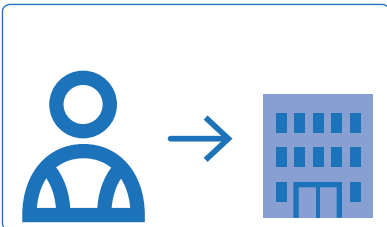


Choosing Your Support... Through Council managed service

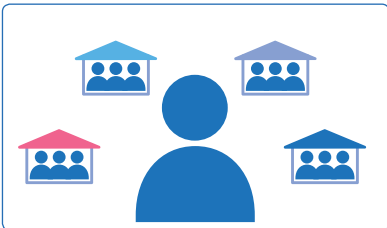
How does it work?



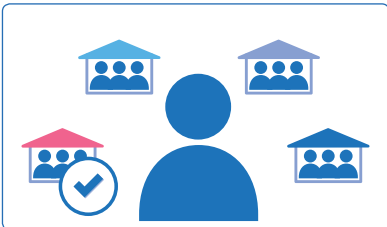
1. You agree your support plan with your social worker.



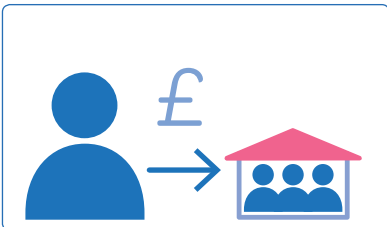
2. You ask the council to decide and arrange your support.

5. Your social worker arranges the support.

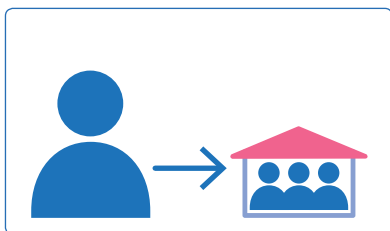


6. If you are not happy with your support, you can speak to your support organisation.

How does it work?

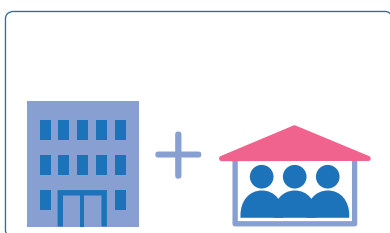


7. If you are still not happy you can speak to your social worker.



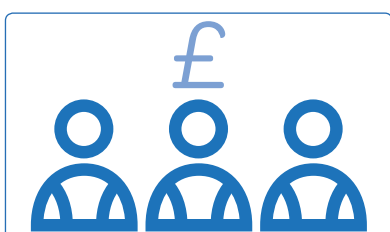
8. Your social worker can arrange changes to your support.
